
Crimp with crimping tools.

Confirm that all wires are fully inserted. Assembly is complete.



3. Peel back the outer sheath so as not to cut the shielding foil. Leave about 25 mm of shielding foil on the peeled area. 4/5. Fold back so as not to damage the shielding foil. Leave about 9.5 mm of the folded-back portion. 6. Fold the drain wire back as well. When inserting the plug, make sure that the drain wire is on the tap side, not the strain

Organize by color code and pass through the included guide. Then insert up to the tip of the modular plug.



Insert the cable firmly up to the tip. At the same time, insert so that the shielded part makes contact with the plug metal part.



Crimp with crimping tools. Confirm that all wires are fully inserted. Cut off the unnecessary aluminum foil and drain wire at the base with scissors, etc. Assembly is complete.
